**Tulsa County Court Clerk Receiving Motions, Pleadings, and New Filings**

Yesterday, Presiding District Court Judge William LaFortune issued an Administrative Order closing the courts until April 20, 2020, due to the threat of COVID-19. While the courts are closed, the Tulsa County Court Clerk's office remains open in the Tulsa County Courthouse, but with limited staff.

The office is still receiving critical court documents such as motions, pleadings, and new filings from attorneys or runners and through the U.S. Postal Service. Motions and pleadings in current matters are being accepted. Cases may be pending before court dates are assigned.
