RULES FOR SUPERVISED VISITATION

1. Petitioner/Respondent (circle one) has been ordered to have supervised visitation with the subject minor child.
2. During periods of supervised visitation:
 - a. The Supervisor shall be able to see and hear all interactions between the supervised parent and the subject child(ren); and the Supervisor shall not leave the supervised party alone with the child(ren).
 - b. The Supervisor shall at all times be within the immediate presence of the supervised parent. "Immediate presence" means in the same room, within view and within earshot.
 - c. The Supervisor shall not allow third parties to be present at supervised visitations absent written agreement of the parties or an Order of the Court.
 - d. The supervised party is prohibited from discussing the legal proceeding and prohibited from making any derogatory remarks regarding the other party.
 - e. The supervised party and the Supervisor are prohibited from consuming or being under the influence of any alcoholic beverage or illegal drugs. Further, there shall not be any alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs anywhere around the minor child(ren) to include restaurants or indoor/outdoor visitation locations.
 - f. In the event the visitation Supervisor observes any erratic behavior, violation of the rules of supervised visitation, signs of any suspected substance abuse, or anything else that gives rise to any concerns regarding the mental and/or physical health and safety of the minor child(ren), it is the duty of the visitation Supervisor to terminate the visitation and report the incident in writing to the Court.

- g. Any person or party transporting the subject child(ren) to or from supervised visitation must maintain a valid drivers license.

AFFIDAVIT OF VOLUNTEER VISITATION SUPERVISOR

That I have read and understand my duties and responsibilities under the RULES FOR SUPERVISED VISITATION attached hereto and that I will abide by the terms of the RULES FOR SUPERVISED VISITATION.

I further acknowledge that the safety and best interest of the subject minor child(ren) is the primary concern of the Court.

I recognize the appointment of an individual as visitation Supervisor is a Court Order. I understand that failure to comply with the responsibilities set forth above could result in discharge as visitation Supervisor or other sanction by the Court. I have submitted a national criminal history record check report issued by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation within one (1) year prior to my appointment as Supervisor.

By my signature below, I further state under oath that I am *not*:

- a. an alcohol-dependent or drug-dependent person,
- b. residing with a person who is required by law to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act of this state or any other state,
- c. residing with a person who has been convicted of domestic abuse within the past five (5) years,

and that I have *not*:

- d. had custody, guardianship, or visitation rights terminated to any child.

ORDER APPROVING VOLUNTEER VISITATION SUPERVISOR

Pursuant to 43 O.S. Section 110.1A (eff. November 1, 2024), the Court has reviewed and considered the following evidence and information prior to approval of the above-named volunteer to supervise child visitation as ordered, and the Court has thereafter made findings and determinations below:

1. A national criminal history record check conducted by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation within one (1) year prior to the appointment of the volunteer;
2. A sworn affidavit from the volunteer accepting the rules of supervision and agreeing to abide by same, and stating whether the volunteer:
 - a. is an alcohol- or drug-dependent person,
 - b. is residing with a person who is required by law to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act of this state or any other state,
 - c. is residing with a person who has been convicted of domestic abuse within the past five (5) years, or
 - d. has had custody, guardianship, or visitation rights terminated to any child.
3. Any testimony by the potential volunteer or other witness testimony deemed necessary by the court to determine the fitness of the volunteer.

4. Other evidence or information: _____

BASED ON THE FOREGOING THE COURT FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

The above-named volunteer visitation supervisor is a fit person to supervise such child visitation as ordered by the Court, and the volunteer is *not*:

- a. an alcohol- or drug-dependent person,
- b. residing with a person who is required by law to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act of this state or any other state,
- c. residing with a person who has been convicted of domestic abuse within the past five (5) years, or
- d. has had custody, guardianship, or visitation rights terminated to any child.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS AND ORDERS, the above-named volunteer child visitation supervisor has acknowledged the rules of such visitation supervision and agreed to abide by same during episodes of visitation as ordered by the Court. The Court hereby appoints above-named volunteer as the child visitation supervisor for the subject child(ren) and supervised parent, and orders that the volunteer supervising the visitation shall be able to see and hear all interactions between the supervised parent and the child(ren) during such court-ordered visitation.
